ORDINANCE NO: 37

AN ORDINANCE TO PROTECT THE RESIDENTS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RILEY BY ENACTING STANDARDS FOR PROVISION OF SAFE ELECTRICAL SERVICE FOR ANY BUILDING, STRUCTURE OR USE WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF RILEY, COUNTY OF ST. CLAIR, STATE OF MICHIGAN; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS, COLLECTION OF FEES THEREFORE, MAKING OF INSPECTIONS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE TOWNSHIP OF RILEY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1: TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known and cited, and shall hereafter be referred to, as the RILEY TOWNSHIP ELECTRICAL CODE.

SECTION 2: PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide minimum standards to safeguard life and/or limb, and the public health, safety and general welfare of persons and/or property within the Township of Riley by enacting standards for provision of safe electrical service for any building, structure or use within the Township of Riley; by regulating the same; providing for the issuance of permits, collection of fees therefore; making of inspections; providing penalties for violation thereof; and repealing Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict therewith.

SECTION 3: ADOPTION OF NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE

The Township of Riley does hereby adopt by reference the 1990 National Electrical Code (NEPA 70/1990), and the Technical Amendments to the said 1990 Edition of the National Electrical Code as the Electrical Code of the Township of Riley.

SECTION 4: ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT

This Ordinance shall be administered and enforced by the Riley Township Electrical Inspector, who shall be appointed by the Riley Township Board.

SECTION 5: FEES

Fees for inspections and permits under and pursuant to this Ordinance shall be determined by resolution of the Riley Township Board.

SECTION 6: VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

A violation of any provision of this Ordinance and/or Code by any person or entity shall constitute a misdemeanor. Any person or entity who violates a provision of this Ordinance and Code shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine of not more than the sum of Five Hundred and 00/100 (\$500.00) Dollars, or imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court. Each and every day, during which such violation continues, shall be deemed a separate offense.

In addition, injunctive proceedings may also be instituted to prevent or enjoin any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance and Code.

SECTION 7: SEVERABILITY

This Ordinance and the various parts, sections, subsections, sentences, phrases and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION 8: REPEAL AND SAVINGS CLAUSE

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its publication in The Voice.

SECTION 10: ADOPTION

This Ordinance was duly adopted by the Riley Township Board at a regular meeting thereof held on the 5th day of November, 1990.

ORDINANCE # 37-01
ELECTRICAL CODE ORDINANCE

Notice is hereby given that an Ordinance to Adopt and/or amend the Michigan State Electrical Code, was adopted by the Riley Township Board at a meeting held on May 7, 2001. On that day a motion was made by Linda Waddy and supported by Linda Belesky, to adopt said ordinance. Motion carried.

This Ordinance is for safeguarding life and property by regulating, and providing for the installation, alteration, repairing, servicing and maintenance of electrical equipment; to provide for the administration and enforcement thereof, to provide a penalty for violations thereof and to repeal all ordinances in conflict therewith.

Code adopted: Pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan Electrical Code, in accordance with Section 89 of Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972 as amended, the elected official of the Township of Riley is hereby the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Riley.

Licensing shall be administered by the State of Michigan, pursuant to Section 6, of the Electrical Administrative Act 217, or the Michigan Electrical Administrative Board.

Effective date of this Ordinance shall be May 31, 2001.
