An ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Riley located in St. Clair County, and to designate regulated flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.	
The Township of Riley ordains:	
Section 1. AGENCY DESIGNATED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Building Official of the Township of Riley is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Riley under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Township of Riley assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act through out the corporate limits of the community adopting this ordinance.	
Section 2. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED. Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the Township of Riley.	
Section 3. DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled St. Clair County, Michigan (All Jurisdictions) and dated May 3, 2010 (Effective Study does not exist at this time.) (Date) and the Flood Insurance Rate Map(s (FIRMS) panel number(s) of 26147CO; 0280D, 0290D, 0294D, 0295D, 0305D, 0315D (Effective Panels do no exist at this time.) and dated May 3, 2010 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code, and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code, and to provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Code.	}
Section 4. REPEALS. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.	
Section 4. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.
